CORRIGENDUM

In the Order No. 163/2018-CUS /ASRA/MUMBAI dated 28.03.2018 in para 8 of page 4

“ Government allows redemption of the confiscated gold chain weighing 71.4 gms totally valued at Rs. 2,03,186/- (Rupees Two lacs Three thousand One hundred and eighty six) is reduced from 1,02,000/- (Rupees One lac two thousand)to Rs. 75,000/- (Seventy five thousand)under section 125 of the Customs Act, 1962. Government also observes that the facts of the case justify slight reduction in the penalty imposed. The penalty imposed on the Applicant is therefore reduced from Rs. 75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five thousand) to Rs 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand) under section 112(a) of the Customs Act,1962.”

May be read as

“ Government allows redemption of the confiscated gold chain weighing 71.4 gms totally valued at Rs. 2,03,186/- (Rupees Two lacs Three thousand One hundred and eighty six) for re-export. The redemption fine is reduced from 1,02,000/- (Rupees One lac two thousand)to Rs. 75,000/- (Seventy five thousand)under section 125 of the Customs Act, 1962. Government also observes that the facts of the case justify slight reduction in the penalty imposed. The penalty imposed on the Applicant is therefore reduced from Rs. 21,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five thousand) to Rs 15,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand) under section 112(a) of the Customs Act,1962”
