ORDER

This Revision Application has been filed by M/s. Amber Distilleries Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "the applicant"). Brief facts of the case are that the Applicant is the exporter of the Maiwand and Champion Whisky and had filed the application for fixation of brand rate on 04.02.2013 to the commissioner of Central Excise, Dadar against export of Maiwand whisky. The Applicant while filing the Application of Condonation of delay for Fixation of Brand Rate of their export goods, specified, the reason for the delay as they are able to export only 8-10 containers per year and instead of filing 8-10 applications, they decided to club it in one application to reduce the Paper Work. The Commissioner of Excise rejected the Applicant's request for above stated matter stating that he is not convinced by the reason advanced by the Applicant in support of the condonation.

2. Being aggrieved and dissatisfied with the impugned order, the applicant had filed this revision Application under Section 129 DD of the Customs Act, 1962 before the Government.

3. Now, vide their letter dated 24.09.2019 applicant has informed that they do not want to pursue the Revision Application as they had inadvertently filed it in this RA office, and therefore wish to withdraw the application. Thus, Government allows the applicant to withdraw current revision application.

4. The Revision Application is dismissed as withdrawn.
