I am directed to refer to your online application dated 05/03/2015 received by this section on 11/03/2015 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the work allocated to the division relates to administration of AIS Act and Rules, including AIS(DCRB) Rules, 1958 and dealing with service matters of IAS officers.

2. On perusal of the RTI application, it is observed that the applicant has sought for information related to Voluntary Retirement from Service of IAS, IPS, IRS and IFS Officers. Since, service conditions of aforesaid Officers are being controlled by respective Cadre Controlling Authorities i.e. IAS by the Department of Personnel & Training, IPS by the Ministry of Home Affairs, IRS by the Ministry of Finance and IFS by the Ministry of External Affairs, requisite information in respect of IPS, IRS & IFS officers falls under the jurisdiction of Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Finance and Ministry of External Affairs, respectively.

3. So far as information in respect of IAS officers is concerned, it may be stated that information Pertaining to voluntary retirement in respect of IAS Officers is not centrally maintained as in terms of Rule 16(2) of AIS(DCRB) Rules, 1958(copy enclosed), concerned State Government is the competent authority for granting VRS to the officer, who have completed 30 years of qualifying service or 50 years of age, Whereas in term of Rule 16(2A) of AIS(DCRB) Rules, 1958(copy enclosed), Central Government is the competent authority for granting VRS to the officer, who have completed 20 years of qualifying service. However, information relating to IAS officer who have taken voluntary retirement, from the year 2005 onwards as maintained/available with this Department is enclosed herewith. Besides, for other part your RTI application is being forwarded to the concerned CPIO.


