NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the , 2018

G.S.R. .— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'A' Executive posts in the Goods and Services Tax Council Secretariat, Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Goods and Services Tax Council Secretariat, Group 'A' Executive Posts Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.—The number of said posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;
or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 1: Vacancies remaining unfilled from the quota allocated to the State Governments above shall be filled up from the officers of Central Government including officers of Indian Revenue Service (Customs and Central Excise), subject to the eligibility as below: a.(i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or the department; or (ii) with three years regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto in Level-13 in the Pay Matrix vide VII th Pay Commission; and b. fifteen years experience in the service including three years experience in matter relating to indirect taxation Note 2: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the last date of the receipt of applications.
