Shri Sahil Ratra may refer to communication dated 06.02.2014 of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare regarding his online application, Registration No. MOHFW/R/2014/80035, seeking information under the Right to Information Act, 2005, received in Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue) on 13.02.2014.

2. Under the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) is required to provide information, which may be available in any form and held by it, rather than giving 'personal opinion' on the question asked by an applicant. The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and the rules / orders / other notifications made / issued there under are self explanatory and in public domain.
3. Aforesaid application of Shri Sahil Ratra is treated as disposed of at this level. However, if Shri Sahil Ratra is not satisfied with the above information, he may prefer an appeal, within a period of 30 days, to the Appellate Authority, viz. Director (NC), Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, North Block, New Delhi-110001.
